

THE RULES OF STUDENT CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE ORDINANCE NO 2, 2000
ORDINANCE No. 2

In terms of Section 29 (iii) (a) of the Midlands State University Act (Chapter 25:21 of 1999), the Council of the State University in the Midlands with the approval of the Minister of Higher Education, makes the following Ordinance:-

1. The Ordinance may be cited as “The Rules of Student Conduct and Discipline Ordinance, 2000, Ordinance No. 2”.
2. It constitutes the first set of Rules of Student Conduct and Discipline for the Midlands State University.
3. The Rules of Student Conduct and Discipline set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance shall come into effect from the 27th of March 2000.
4. In terms of Section 27 (4) of the University Act, the Student Disciplinary Committee hereby delegates to the Officials referred to in the Rules of Student Conduct and Discipline the power of investigating and exercising disciplinary authority in respect of misconduct by any student to the extent and in the manner set out in the Rules of Student Conduct and Discipline.

In terms of Section 27 (6) of the University Act, the Student Disciplinary Committee may recommend to the Vice-Chancellor the imposition of one or more of the following punishments:-

- 5.1 expulsion or suspension from the University.
- 5.2 the withdrawal of any academic or University privilege, benefit, right of facility other than to follow courses of instruction and present himself for examination.
- 5.3 the imposition of a fine which shall be determined by the University from time to time, which fine may be deducted from any allowance payable to the student and shall be paid to the University
- 5.4 a censure or rimand.
- 5.5 such other penalty as may be provided for by or in terms of the statutes
