

EDITORIAL POLICY AND GENERAL GUIDELINES TO
AUTHORS

The Dyke is a bi-annual, refereed Midlands State University journal serving academics and professionals in the fields of social sciences, commerce, humanities and education.

SUBMISSION INFORMATION

The Journal publishes research papers, essays and reviews that stimulate and contribute to reasoned discussions of diverse issues in the vast fields of Social Sciences, Commerce, Humanities and Education. Papers submitted should report on original and unpublished work that is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Submissions that should be of substantial interest are welcome from academics and practitioners in the noted fields. The style of writing should be in a communicative style with minimum jargon.

MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

A cover letter should state that the manuscript is not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Cover letters should also indicate address and telephone number of the person to whom editorial correspondence is to be addressed, as full names, address and telephone numbers of the author(s).

Manuscripts will be blind reviewed by at least authorities in the field and authors should expect responses about 6 weeks after submission.

FORMAT AND ORGANISATION

Manuscripts should not be longer than 20 typewritten pages inclusive of reference list and appendices. Double-space all text, including references, figure captions, footnotes, and tables. Prepare manuscripts for blind review hence the title page with author(s) names and their organizational affiliation(s) should be detachable. In the paper there should be no material that can enable the reviewer to know or infer the name of the author(s).

REFERENCES

Use the Harvard referencing style through out the paper. Provide page numbers for chapters in edited books. A full reference list should be typed in alphabetical order at the end of the paper.
